17.3 SPECIAL CONDITIONS

ANSWERING SERVICE

Answering Service employs an extension line, extension of a trunk line, or PBX extension line from a primary service terminating on telephone answering equipment and is furnished for the sole purpose of enabling the designated answering service company to answer incoming calls of the customer. Such lines are equipped to prevent outgoing calls.

Answering Service line service is not offered for:

Outgoing exchange or toll calls;

Intercommunication between the customer and the designated answering company over the answering service line;

Connections between the answering service line and a central office line or other answering service line through the designated answering service company.
