**26.1 GENERAL**

26.1.1 APPLICABILITY

Applicable to Remote Call Forwarding.

**26.3 SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

(A) DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

Remote Call Forwarding Service (primary access) is an arrangement which includes the furnishing of a network address (telephone number) to an applicant or customer, which will permit three (3) simultaneous calls completed to another network address. Each additional path permits one (1) additional simultaneous call. Each Remote Call Forwarding Service may have a maximum of ninety-six (96) additional paths.

(B) RATE REGULATIONS

(1) Remote Call Forwarding

- (a) Requires special central office equipment and will be provided only where facilities are available.
- (b) Is furnished to customers who have service arrangements to answer forwarded calls. Customers subscribing to Remote Call Forwarding Service are not required to have a premises in the exchange in which the Remote Call Forwarding Service network address is furnished.

26.3 SPECIAL CONDITIONS - (Cont'd)

(B) RATE REGULATIONS - (Cont'd)

(1) Remote Call Forwarding - (Cont'd)

- (c) Does not include an instrument in the exchange in which the service is located.
- (d) Will be provided only when: (1) the calls are forwarded to a seven digit or area code + seven digit telephone number or seven digit Feature Group B (FGB) Access Code, and (2) the location to which the calls are forwarded are not coin-box service stations.
- (e) Is subject to transmission limitations, so that the quality of transmission of calls which are forwarded may vary depending on the distance and the routing necessary to complete each call and normal transmission is not guaranteed on any forwarded call. This service is not represented as being suitable for the transmission of data or for connection to other services beyond the premises of the terminating primary station.
- (f) May be provided with local service, Toll Free Number service, FGB Access Service, Centrex Service or Fair Oaks foreign exchange service.
- (g) Is furnished for a minimum period of one month.
- (h) Will not be arranged to forward calls from one Remote Call Forwarding network address to another Remote Call Forwarding network address.
- (i) Will not be arranged to forward calls that require international access codes (International Direct Dialing).
- (j) Multi-element service charges as set forth in Schedule Cal. P.U.C. A28, will apply to this service.

(2) Message Charges

- (a) The Call Forwarding Service customer is responsible for the payment of applicable charges for each completed call between their call forwarding equipped line and the number to which the call is forwarded. This charge, local, message unit or dial station toll, applies to all forwarded calls that are answered at the number to which the calls are forwarded.

(B) RATE REGULATIONS - (Cont'd)

(2) Message Charges - (Cont'd)

- (b) Charges between the originating station and the call forwarding equipped station are applicable in accordance with regularly filed tariffs, local, message unit, dial station, operator station or person toll.
- (c) It is the responsibility of the customer forwarding calls to another service to obtain any necessary permission of the customer to whom the calls are forwarded. Rule No. 11 prohibits interference of telephone service of another customer.
- (d) Remote Call Forwarding Service will be a measured rate service.
- (e) The Remote Call Forwarding Service does not include a local message unit allowance or a zone calling unit allowance.

(C) DIRECTORY LISTINGS

- (1) Listings in the directory serving the exchange in which the Remote Call Forwarding Service is located will be furnished equivalent to those provided for business and residence individual line service in Schedule Cal P.U.C. A15.
- (2) The network address and or listed name of the Remote Call Forwarding Service may be changed at the charges as shown in RATES above.

(D) LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Provisions covering limitation of liability and allowance for interruptions in service set forth in Schedule Cal. P.U.C. A2, Rule No. 24, shall apply to this service.
