Switched Alternate Route Service is a service that, when ordered by the customer and activated by the Utility, will redirect all or part of the customer's incoming switched voice and data calls to another location(s) of the customer's choice.

A45. SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES

45.2.1 SPECIAL CONDITIONS

(A) SWITCHED ALTERNATE ROUTE SERVICE FOR HEWLETT PACKARD

- (1) This service is not automatic. The customer must call the Utility to activate/deactivate or make changes in the service.
- (2) This service will be activated/deactivated within one (1) hour upon request during normal working hours as defined in Schedule No. A20, "Inside Wire Maintenance." Requests received during hours other than normal, activations/deactivations will be within two (2) hours upon request.
- (3) Utility assumes no liability for the redirecting of calls to numbers that are incorrectly provided to the Utility by the customer.
- (4) It is the responsibility of the customer redirecting calls to a third party to obtain, when appropriate, the third party's permission prior to the calls being redirected.
- (5) The monthly rate per line is based on the number of telephone numbers equipped. As the customer moves from one size category to the next, the rate for that size category will apply for all telephone numbers equipped.
- (6) All applicable usage charges for calls between the Switched Alternate Route Service equipped telephone number and the telephone number to which those calls are redirected are the responsibility of the Switched Alternate Route Service customer.
- (7) The customer must have sufficient lines and associated facilities to handle the estimated or actual number of calls without interfering with exchange or toll services.

In the event that there is interference with exchange or toll service, the Utility reserves the right to disconnect the service immediately in accordance with the regulations contained in its Tariff.

- (8) Switched Alternate Route Service will not be provided in connection with Public, Semi-public or Mobile Telephone service.
