46.3 SPECIAL CONDITIONS

(A) LIMITATIONS

- (1) Service will be furnished to the extent that facilities permit.
- (2) Customer's must arrange for the establishment of a conference connection at a specified time, duration and port size (simultaneous connections).
- (3) The Utility makes no guarantees and assumes no liability for accuracy, performance or non performance of the Conference Connection Services. Credit adjustments will be made in accordance with the provisions outlined in Rule 14, "Interruptions and Failures of Service."

(B) RATE REGULATIONS

- (1) The minimum billing period for services provided under this schedule shall be one month.
- (2) The rates and charges shown above are in addition to any and all direct distance (DDD) rates for the period of the conference.
- (3) Chargeable time does not include time lost because of faults or defects in the service.
- (4) The total usage charges for the billing period will be the accumulation of all the individual conferee's minutes at the appropriate per minute rate shown above, less the applicable usage allowance. Each conferee's time, per occurrence (call), will be rounded up to the next whole minute.
- (5) All charges and/or credits on final or partial bills, which are bills for more than the minimum billing period, but less than a 30 day period will be prorated for the actual number of days of service based on a 30 day month.
- (6) Unused port charges shall be based on per port per hour increment or fraction thereof. Ports canceled within 48 hours will not be subjected to the port charge.
- (7) An operator assisted charge will be applicable to assisted inbound meet-me conferences.
- (8) Installation and/or change charge as set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Schedule No. A-28, "Multi-Element Service Charges," are applicable.
- (9) Customized services will be handled on an individual case basis. Rates and installation charges will depend upon customers' individual needs. Any deviation from standard packages constitutes a customized service.
