7.1 GENERAL

7.1.1 APPLICABILITY

Applicable to services in connection with each off-premises extension service lines, Private Branch Exchange (PBX) stations or intercommunicating system stations.

7.1.2 TERRITORY

Within the SureWest Telephone exchange area as said area is defined on map filed as part of the tariff schedules.

7.2 RATES

7.2.1 WITHIN SAME EXCHANGE AREA

Applicable in connection with each off-premise extension located off the premises of which the primary service is located or where there are district areas and the extension service is located in a different wire center within the same exchange.

7.3 **SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

7.3.1 WITHIN SAME EXCHANGE AREA

In this schedule "Channel Termination" means a station, PBX switchboard, telephone answering equipment, or key equipment to which the off-premises line is connected.

(A) RATE REGULATIONS

- (1) Except as otherwise provided, the off-premises extension (channel termination) rates are applicable in connection with stations located off the premises on which the primary service is located or where there are district areas and the extension service is located in a different wire center within the same exchange, in addition to the other rates applicable to the service involved.
- (2) When any primary station under the above rates involved more than one off-premises extension the rate will be computed separately for each off-premises station.
- (4) On and after August 8, 1993, off-premises line service provided on same continuous property will be withdrawn except as follows:
 - (a) The rates and regulations in this schedule apply only to current serving arrangements established prior to August 8, 1993, until such time as they are disconnected. At that time, the Utility will treat such property as new continuous property as set forth in Schedule Cal. P.U.C. A2, 2.1.25, Rule 25, "Demarcation Points."

7.3.1 WITHIN SAME EXCHANGE AREA - (Cont'd)

(B) LIMITATIONS

- (1) When two or more off-premises station services are furnished on the premises of one or more other customers, such other customers shall not use those off-premises station services for communicating with each other.
- (2) Off-premises Extension Service will not be offered in connection with Foreign Exchange Service.

7.3.2 OUTSIDE EXCHANGE AREA

(A) RATE REGULATIONS

- (1) The rates are applicable in connection with off-premises extension services located off the premises on which the primary service is located and in an exchange area contiguous or non-contiguous to that in which the primary service is located, in addition to the rates applicable for such stations on the same premises as the primary service.
- (2) The application of these rates is in accordance with the special conditions governing foreign exchange service.
- (3) When any primary station under the above rates involves more than one off-premises extension station, the rates will be computed separately for each off-premises extension station.
- (4) Inter-office Mileage rates provides for the transmission facilities between the serving wire centers associated with the customers designated primary service and the Off-Premises Extension Service.

(B) LIMITATIONS

- (1) When two or more off-premises station services are furnished on the premises of one or more other customers, such other customers shall not use those off-premises station services for communicating with each other.
- (2) Off-premises Extension Service will not be offered in connection with Foreign Exchange Service.

7.3 SPECIAL CONDITIONS - (Cont'd)

7.3.3 FOREIGN EXCHANGE EXTENSION LINES

Furnished in connection with Centrex, PBX or business primary service extended from either a contiguous or non-contiguous connecting company exchange.

(A) LIMITATIONS

- (1) Service under this schedule will be furnished only to customers having primary service located in a contiguous or non-contiguous connecting company exchange. Service will be furnished where facilities and operating conditions permit.
- (2) The local calling area in connection with service furnished under this schedule will be the local service area effective in connection with the primary service at the customer location in the contiguous or non-contiguous foreign exchange.
- (3) Foreign exchange Centrex, PBX or business service customers are not required to take service of the exchange from which service normally would be rendered.
- (4) Each Centrex extension line will be provided for the use of the Centrex service customer or joint users of the Centrex service.
- (5) Additional listings and lines of information will be furnished to foreign exchange customers in local or foreign exchange directories in accordance with the tariff provisions in effect for the directory containing the additional listing or line of information, except that additional listings containing the address of the extension line service will not be furnished.

7.3.3 FOREIGN EXCHANGE EXTENSION LINES - (Cont'd)

- (6) Except as otherwise provided in this schedule, services furnished in the local exchange will be available in connection with foreign exchange extension line service in accordance with the tariff provisions of the local exchange for the particular classification of service furnished

(B) RATE REGULATIONS

- (1) The toll and message unit rates applicable in connection with toll and message unit service respectively, over foreign exchange Centrex, PBX or business lines will be in accordance with the tariff provisions of the contiguous or non- contiguous foreign exchange from which service is received.
- (2) Multi-element charges as shown in Cal. P.U.C. Schedule A28, will apply to this service.
